What's changing?

NAPLAN is moving from paper-based to online assessment.

NAPLAN Online will provide better assessment, more precise results and faster turnaround of information.

Significant planning, development and research is now underway. An Information and Communications Technology (ICT) Skills Guide, a Technical Readiness Tool, OneChannel programs and training, and student activities and learning resources support school readiness for online assessment.

Five key changes

Paper-based tests	Online tests
Same test for each student cohort	Tailored test for each student
1 Tailored testing delivers sets of questions (testlets) to students that are more suited to their ability, enabling a broader range of skills to be assessed and more precise results.	
Standard results	Precise results
2 Precise results better reflect the unique capabilities of each student.	
Three-day test period	Nine-day test period
3 An extended test period offers schools a nine-day timeframe to schedule tests.	
Hand-writing skills	ICT skills
4 Students need ICT skills such as reading online, and planning and composing digital text.	
Minimal impact on ICT infrastructure	Adequate ICT infrastructure is critical
5 Adequate ICT infrastructure (including bandwidth, devices and network access) will help schools to become technically ready for NAPLAN Online by 2019.	

Students will be presented with sets of questions based on their performance during the test. Many of these questions are of mid-range complexity for each year level, but some are of higher or lower complexity.

OneSchool reporting will be modified to present detailed test results.

An ICT Skills Guide, related resources and learning activities will support digital capability.
